GEORGE HUMPHRY WINS \$1,000 FIRST PRIZE IN MDUSBC SUPER SENIOR MASTERS AT GARDEN BOWL

George Humphry of Grosse Pointe Farms won the MDUSBC Super Senior Masters title and the top prize of \$1,000 at Garden Bowl in Detroit with a 269-226 triumph over Leonard Kersten of Clarkston. Kersten settled for \$500.

Humphry was the top qualifier with a five-game total of 1,221. He remained in the winner's bracket with victories over Robert Szachta of Macomb 216-204, Leonard Cianciolo of Warren 247-237, George Reeves of Detroit 223-191 and Kersten the first time 259-226. Humphry averaged 243.50 for 10 games of competition.

Kersten qualified third with 1,193. He stayed in the winner's bracket with triumphs over Daniel Mayer Jr. of Waterford Township 235-194, John Lingenfelter of Center Line 227-203 and Richard Schultz of Macomb 246-218 before being knocked into the loser's bracket by Humphry 259-226. He then beat Leonard Cianciolo 237-171 for a chance to avenge the loss to Humphry. Kersten finished third in 2014 in the event. Kersten averaged 235.45 for 11 games of competition.

Cianciolo finished third for \$400 and Toswell fourth for \$300.

Cianciolo, the 2009 MDUSBC Super Senior Masters champion, qualified ninth with 1,124 and averaged 223.5 for 12 games. He won his first match against Mitchell Jabczynski Sr. of Novi 194-190 before falling to the loser's bracket with a loss to Humphry 247-237. Once in the loser's bracket he reeled off wins over Michael Chapman of Garden City 256-227, Michael Lucente of Warren 238-235, Richard Schultz 237-203, Ronald Toswell 225-218. He then lost to Kersten 237-171 to end his day.

Toswell qualified 15th with 1,066. He averaged 226 for 11 games of competition. He won his first match against Michael Chapman 290-225 before losing to Richard Schultz 279-193. In the loser's bracket he beat Robert Szachta 60-40 in the third overtime after they tied at 235, John Lingenfelter 247-204, George Reeves 212-182 before being knocked out by Cianciolo 225-218.

Defending champion Gregory Cohen of Livonia finished 13th, averaging 234 and cashing for \$150.

Peter Minaudo of Chesterfield won the special competition to non-qualifiers over the age of 70 with a 234-174 win over Richard Planko of Novi. Minaudo took home \$175 and Planko \$150 for their efforts.
