JOSEPH KRAJENKE WINS \$1,200 FIRST PRIZE IN MDUSBC SUPER SENIOR MASTERS AT MERRI-BOWL LANES

Joseph Krajenke of Clinton Township won the MDUSBC Super Senior Masters title and the top prize of \$1,200 at Merri-Bowl Lanes in Livonia with a 192-190 win over Larry Walker of Garden City. Walker settled for \$600.

As the two-time defending champion, Krajenke was seeded fifth by tournament rule with a five-game total of 1,007. He remained in the winner's bracket with victories over Michael McCleskey of Southfield 201-145, Jeffrey Suma of Clarkston 246-199, Gerald Johnson of Taylor 222-203 and Michael Lucente of Warren 267-212. He then had to wait for Walker to emerge from the loser's bracket. Once Walker emerged, he defeated Krajenke 227-209 to set up the final match. Krajenke averaged 215.2 for 10 games of competition.

Walker qualified 15th with 1,038, despite a disastrous final game of 145. In match play he beat Ted Hannahs of Reynoldsburg, Ohio 193-189 and Robert Michaux of Detroit 258-195 before falling to Lucente 251-202. In the loser's bracket he defeated Suma 236-214, Johnson 189-178 and Lucente 228-190 to advance to the finals. Walker averaged 216.5 for 11 games.

Lucente finished third for \$500 and Johnson fourth for \$400.

Lucente qualified third with 1,115. He won his first three matches over Richard Wayne of Westland 227-224, Daniel Mayer of Davisburg 181-144, Walker 251-202 before losing to Krajenke 267-212. He then lost to Walker 228-190 to end his day. For 10 games, Lucente averaged 217.6.

Johnson was the top qualifier with 1,137. He won his first two matches over Kenneth Allen of Highland Park 225-217 and Sidney Dunbar of Detroit 188-168 before losing to Krajenke 222-203. In the loser's bracket he triumphed over McCleskey 232-203 before losing to Walker 189-178. Johnson averaged 216.3 for 10 games.

Rick Capaldi of Manitou Beach won the special competition for non-qualifiers over the age of 70 with a 191-159 win over Edward Flowers of West Bloomfield. Capaldi took home \$200 and Flowers \$175 for their efforts.

The MDUSBC Super Senior Masters Tournament is an USBC certified event operated by the Metro Detroit USBC, the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress with over 20,000 adult and youth members.
