KYLE HOWARD WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Kyle Howard of Oak Park won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 238-187 triumph over Charles Easton of Sylvania, Ohio at Spins Bowl Waterford. Howard took home the top prize of \$500, while Easton settled for \$250.

Howard qualified fifth in the field of 91, with a four-game total of 867 on games of 223, 234, 215 and 195. In match play he beat Jordan Hornes of Detroit 193-192, Willie Price of Pontiac 215-208 and Jacob Johnson of Redford 226-191 to advance to the championship match.

Easton qualified tenth with 855, including a high game of 244. In match play he defeated Ian Casmier of Ferndale 200-158, Mark Milasinovich of Shelby Twp 178-149, Anthony Moses of Beverly Hills 182-173 and Brian Odom of Westland 257-177 on his way to the finals.

Harold Hughes of Auburn Hills led the field with 896 on games of 199, 235, 215 and 247. In losing his first match he took home \$75.
