CHARLES ZELECHOWSKI WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Charles Zelechowski of Westland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 226-176 victory over Carl Boldt of Pontiac at Spins Bowl Waterford (Century Bowl) in Waterford. Zelechowski took home the top prize of \$500, while Boldt earned \$250.

Zelechowski qualified seventh in the field of 82, with a four-game total of 856 on games of 201, 240, 212 and 203. In match play, he beat Kristofer Dettloff of Davisburg 178-137, William Holmes of Southfield 195-164 and Ryan Land of Royal Oak 279-220 to advance to the championship match.

Boldt qualified tied for 20th and the final qualifying match play position with 789. In a one game tie breaker, he defeated Brandan Cavalli of Sterling Heights 200-180 to move forward in the competition. In match play, he beat Alex Robinson of Detroit 219-179, John Robertson of Waterford 215-204, Dwayne Anderson of Southfield 201-180 and Gerald Johnson of Taylor 183-159 on his way to the finals.

Chris Clark of Lowell led the field of 82 bowlers with 905 on games of 267, 211, 217 and 210. In losing his first match, he took home \$75.

Anthony Wright of Detroit won the season long Cup race with 715 points. Johnson and Boldt finished second and third respectively with 672 and 653 points.
