STEPHEN KRYWY AND DASHA KOVALOVA WIN MIXED BAKER DOUBLES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Stephen Krywy of Sterling Heights and Dasha Kovalova of Muskegon won the MDUSBC Women's Series / Men's Series Mixed Baker Doubles Sunday with a 385-325 two-game Baker Style win over George Juszczuk of Dearborn Heights and Madalyn Klein of Dearborn Heights at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. The Kovalova-Krywy team took home the top prize of \$1,000, while the Klein-Juszczuk duo settled for \$500.

The Kovalova-Krywy team qualified fourth in the field of 49 with an eight-game total of 1,731. In match play, they beat Dennis Johnson of Wyoming and Emily Witt of Grand Rapids 420-381 and Tempel Johnson of Southfield and Keith Caldwell of Detroit 402-345 to advance to the finals.

The duo of Klein and Juszczuk qualified second with 1,764. They advanced to the finals with a 447-343 triumph over Robin and Billy Orlikowski of Grand Rapids. Previously, they defeated Julia Huren and Charles Zelechowski both of Westland 399-336.

The MDUSBC Women's Series is now in its 12th year of operations and the fifth year for the Men's Series by the Metro Detroit USBC.
