MORGAN MALISZEWSKI AND DONOVAN ROMITA WIN MDUSBC JUNIOR MASTERS TITLES AT SPINS BOWL TROY

Donovan Romita of St. Clair Shores prevailed in the boy's division and Morgan Maliszewski of Brighton won the girl's division of the Metro Detroit USBC Junior Masters at Spins Bowl Troy (Bowl One Lanes) in Troy.

Romita qualified first with a six-game total of 1,250. He beat Aaron Hill of Wayne in an exciting 226-213 match. Hill qualified 2nd with a 1,247.

Maliszewski defeated top seed Sophia Best of Redford 205-169 to win the girl's title. Maliszewski qualified 2nd with a six-game total of 1,159, while Best's qualifying score was 1,172.

The boy's stepladder began with Zachary McMichael of Warren beating Jason Palsean of Oxford 214-173 before falling to Dylan Harnden of Shelby Twp. 200-171. Hill then beat Harnden 167-149 to advance to the championship match.

The girl's stepladder began with Kayla Tafanelli of Warren beat Morgan Petroff of Warren 225-192 before Maliszewski defeated Tafanelli 176-167 on her way to the finals.

The event was a USBC Junior Gold qualifying event. Maliszewski earned the girl's spot, while Palsean earned a boy's spot as the higher finishers had previously qualified in other tournaments.

A total of 74 youth bowlers participated in the scratch event, 50 boys and 24 girls.

The MDUSBC Junior Masters Tournament is a USBC certified event operated by the Metro Detroit USBC Association, the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress with over 30,000 adult and youth bowlers.
