DARREN ALEXANDER WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL AND TIES WITH COREY MILLER FOR THE TOP POINT TOTAL IN THIS FIVE EVENT SERIES

Darren Alexander of Essex, Ont., won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event Sunday with a 231-181 triumph over Corey Miller of Waterford at Westland Bowl. Alexander took home the top prize of \$500, while Miller earned \$250. In totaling the points over the five-event series, Alexander and Miller tie for the top point total in this five-event series.

Alexander qualified second in the field of 57, with a four-game total of 936 on games of 242, 244, 212 and 238. In match play he beat Michael McCleskey of Southfield 237-215, Jeffrey Austreng of Waterford 235-225 and Jonathan Dean of Casco 244-222 to advance to the championship match.

Miller qualified first with 976, including a high game of 279. In match play he defeated Mark Milasinovich of Shelby Twp 204-148, Ryan Land of Royal Oak 253-190 and Logan Mills of Plymouth 246-223 on his way to the finals.
