MYKAELA MITCHELL WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Mykaela Mitchell of Windsor, Ont was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 227-178 triumph over Chelsey Klingler of Cedar Springs at Spins Bowl Waterford (Century Bowl). Mitchell took home the top prize of \$500 while Klingler earned \$250.

Mitchell qualified fifth in the field of 36 with a four-game total of 930 on games of 241, 223, 207 and 259. In reaching the finals against Klingler, she beat Nicole Wilson of Northville 268-229 and Emily Rettig of Novi 267-239 on her way to the finals.

Klingler qualified second with 954, which included games of 256, 259, 237 and 202. In reaching the finals against Mitchell, she defeated Melissa Biss of Livonia 202-192 and Bailey Gipson of Davison 200-181.

Rettig was the top qualifier with a four-game total of 997 on games of 223, 238, 257 and 279. In her match play loss to Mitchell, Rettig took home \$100.
