MICHELLE BERRYMAN CAPTURES MDUSBC SENIOR QUEENS AT PLAZA LANES

Michelle Berryman of Milford won the Metro Detroit USBC Senior Queens on Saturday with a 212-195 triumph over defending champion, Lesia Lambert of Allen Park at Plaza Lanes in Plymouth.

Berryman was the top qualifier for the stepladder finals with a four-game total of 908 on games of 203, 211, 227 and a strong finishing 267. As the top seed, she had to wait for the challenger to emerge.

Lambert qualified fourth with a four-game total of 808. Her totals included a high game of 217. She defeated Carmeletha Allen of Detroit 212-191 then Tanisha Burris of Holt 213-199 to advance to the championship match.

Burris qualified second with a four-game total of 852 on games of 235, 257, 189 and 171 before losing to Lambert.

Allen qualified third with a four-game total of 822 on games of 146, 245, 216 and 215 before losing to Lambert.

This was the 16th year of the MDUSBC Senior Queens. Initial qualifying was done by senior women 50 years of age and older with their actual all-events of the recently completed MDUSBC Women's Championship. The top bowlers advanced to the qualifying finals.
