DARREN ALEXANDER WINS MEN'S "TURBO CUP" SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES

Darren Alexander of Essex, Ontario won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series Invitational event on Sunday with a 225-219 triumph over Matthew Bederka of Romulus. This is a back to back win for Alexander as he won the previous event at Westland Bowl in April. Alexander took home the top prize of \$500, while Bederka earned \$250.

Alexander qualified fourth with 829 on games of 185, 246, 185 and 213. In the stepladder finals he beat Kenji London of Ann Arbor 300-202. London cashed for \$100. In his second match, Alexander beat the second-place qualifier, Lonnie Lawrence of Wayne 246-191 and advanced to the finals. Lawrence cashed for \$150.

Bederka was the top qualifier in the invitational field with a four-game total of 952 on games of 238, 257, 214 and 243 to advance to the stepladder finals and wait for a challenger.

The invited bowlers qualified for the Invitational at Shelby Lanes based on the points earned during the five-event series, winning at least one event during the season or bowling every in every event.

After the competition, the event participants were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Alexander and Corey Miller of Waterford each earned \$450 as co-champions with 798 points for the Men's Turbo Cup five-event series, followed by Ryan Land of Royal Oak with 688 points for 200.
