JACOB JOHNSON WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Jacob Johnson of Redford won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event Sunday with a 256-209 triumph over Jacob Kujawa of Sterling Heights at Spins Bowl Waterford (Century Bowl). Johnson took home the top prize of \$500, while Kujawa earned \$250.

Johnson qualified third in the field of 83, with a four-game total of 933 on games of 258, 227, 191 and 257. In match play he beat David Fuller of Chesterfield 222-180, Corey Miller of Waterford 251-246 and Conner Weber of Wayne 230-154 to advance to the championship match.

Kujawa qualified eighth with 918, including a high game of 257. In match play he defeated Ryan Land of Royal Oak 216-205, Dylan Jablonski of Canton 257-204 and Logan Mills of Plymouth 212-175 on his way to the finals.

In rolling a perfect 300 score in the last game of the qualifying round, Jordan Born of White Lake qualified seventh with a four-game total of 920. In the first round of match play, Born lost to Weber 224-201 and took home \$75.
