KEEGAN MCCLAIN AND ALBERT GUZMAN WIN THE MDUSBC JUNIOR MASTERS TITLES AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Keegan McClain of Lincoln Park prevailed in the girl's division and Albert Guzman of Farmington won the boy's division of the Metro Detroit USBC Junior Masters at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park.

McClain was the top seeded qualifier and waited for fourth seeded Rochelle Ferris of Roseville to continue through the stepladder to reach the finals. McClain defeated Ferris 191-189. McClain qualified first with a six-game total of 1,155 including a high game of 224. Ferris had a qualifying score of 1,041 with a high game of 247.

Guzman qualified fifth with a six-game total of 1,094 and a high game of 217. He beat top seed Myron Pickett of Detroit 222-176 in the championship match. Pickett qualified with a six-game total of 1,208.

The girl's stepladder began with Ferris beating Ava Mazza of Shelby Twp 231-219 and Jacey Thibodeau of Warren 223-203 before advancing to the championship match.

The boy's stepladder began with Guzman defeating Dylan Harnden of Shelby Twp 160-158 then Clinton Harris III of Warren 169-164 and Michael Pupin of New Baltimore 175-157 on his way to the finals.

The event was a USBC Junior Gold qualifying event. Megan Redmond of Marysville earned the girl's spot, while Guzman and Pickett earned the boy's spots.

A total of 60 youth bowlers participated in this scratch event including 46 boys and 14 girls.

The MDUSBC Junior Masters Tournament is a USBC certified event operated by the Metro Detroit USBC Association, the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress.
