AMANDA BARRY AND DAVID REAUME WIN MIXED BAKER DOUBLES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Amanda Barry of Clinton Township and David Reaume of St. Clair Shores won the MDUSBC Women's Series / Men's Series Mixed Baker Doubles Sunday with a 457-371 two-game Baker Style win over Mykaela Mitchell of London, Ontario and Dylin Hunter Tecumseh, Ontario at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. The Barry-Reaume team took home the top prize of \$800, while the Mitchell-Hunter duo settled for \$400.

The Barry-Reaume team qualified ninth in the field of 42 with an eight-game total of 1,595. In match play they beat Toary Taylor of Redford and Brandon Bingham of Oak Park 431-369, top qualifiers Robin Orlikowski and Bill Orlikowski of Grand Rapids 374-365 and Anna Heichel of Orion and Mason Brantley of Detroit 453-410 to advance to the finals.

The duo of Mitchell and Hunter qualified third with 1,721. They advanced to the finals with a 444-352 triumph over Tanecia and Travis Wilson of Detroit 444-352 and Jackie and Steve Kosier of Sylvania, Ohio 452-401.

A total of 42 teams participated in the Women's / Men's Series Mixed Baker Doubles event. The MDUSBC Women's Series is now in its ninth year of operations and the second year for the Men's Series by the Metro Detroit USBC.
