STACEY TIMMER AND FRANK SNODGRASS WIN MIXED BAKER DOUBLES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Stacey Timmer of Wayland and Frank Snodgrass of Center Line won the MDUSBC Women's Series / Men's Series Mixed Baker Doubles Sunday 448-367 two-game Baker Style win over Charles Zelechowski of Westland and Julia Huren of Westland at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. The Timmer-Snodgrass team took home the top prize of \$1,000, while the Zelechowski-Huren duo settled for \$500.

The Timmer-Snodgrass team were the top qualifiers in the field of 48 with an eight-game total of 1,776. In match play, they beat Dennis Johnson of Wyoming and Emily Witt of Grand Rapids 445-418 and Gerald Johnson and Brandie Reamy-Johnson of Taylor 427-422 to advance to the finals.

The duo of Zelechowski and Huren qualified second with 1,761. Zelechowski shot a 300 in game four to propel them to second place in qualifying. They advanced to the finals with a 475-372 triumph over Olivia Clark of Jackson and Conner Lackey of Jackson and Ashley Denard of Southfield and Leandre Thomas of Detroit 394-347.

The MDUSBC Women's Series is now in its 11th year of operations and the fourth year for the Men's Series by the Metro Detroit USBC.
