### **JENNA POLLAK WINS MDUSBC QUEENS AT FRASER STAR LANES**

Jenna Pollak of Fraser defeated Sheri Verespej of Newport 214-152 in the final match to win the MDUSBC Queens at Fraser Star Lanes in Fraser. Pollak won the title and \$1,000, while Verespej settled for \$500.

Pollak was the top qualifier with a six-game total of 1,495 on games of 267, 234, 235, 244, 257 and 258. In match play, she beat Pamela Wilson of Woodhaven 222-202, Sonja Butler of Detroit 233-223 and Caitlyn Baker of Waterford 173-144 on her way to the final match. She averaged 233.7 for 10 games of competition.

Verespej, the fourth place finisher in 2020, qualified second with 1,330 with a high game of 268. In match play, she beat Christina Howard of Oak Park 189-164, Meagan Batka of Mt. Pleasant 245-167 and Makayla Lancioni of New Hudson 194-169 leading to the championship match. She averaged 211 for 10 games.

Baker and Lancioni finished third and fourth respectively for \$250 each.

Defending champion Julia Huren of Westland lost her first match and finished ninth for \$105.

The entire 45 person qualifying field averaged 192.9.
