BRIAN WALICZEK WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL

Brian Waliczek of Frankenmuth won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 258-239 triumph over Ronnie Sparks Jr. of Redford at Westland Bowl in Westland. Waliczek took home the top prize of \$500, while Sparks settled for \$250.

Waliczek qualified seventh in the field of 40, with a four-game total of 902 on games of 259, 236, 207 and 200. In match play he beat Michael Dickerson of Detroit 274-218, last month's winner Darren Alexander of Essex, Ontario 258-195 and Tom Smallwood of Saginaw 238-226 to advance to the championship match.

Sparks led qualifying with 1,011, including a high game of 259. In match play he narrowly beat Justin Knowles of Okemos 189-188 and Brian Odom of Romulus 258-244 on his way to the finals.

Alexander leads the Cup race with 216 points. Second and third place are Dan Pollak of Clinton Township and Brian Odom with 194 and 193 respectively.
