GERALD SIKORA WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL

Gerald Sikora of Ecorse won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 212-170 triumph over Nicholas Luther of Fennville at Westland Bowl in Westland. Sikora took home the top prize of \$500, while Luther settled for \$250.

Sikora qualified ninth in the field of 66, with a four-game total of 835 on games of 190, 138, 248 and 259. In match play he beat Craig Johnson of New Boston 192-173, LeAndre Thomas of Novi 244-206 and Conner Weber of Wayne 233-204 to advance to the championship match.

Luther qualified fourteenth with 817, including a high game of 258. In match play he defeated Terrence Bell of Pontiac 229-213, Raymond Cerekas of Warren 279-189 and Josh Regnier of Lansing 211-206 on his way to the finals.

LeAndre Thomas of Novi led the field with 956 on games of 257, 212, 254 and 233. In losing his second match he took home \$100.
