TREY RAYNES WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT STERLING LANES

Trey Raynes of Westland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 206-154 triumph over Chris Clark of Lowell at Sterling Lanes in Sterling Heights. Raynes took home the top prize of \$500, while Clark settled for \$250.

Raynes qualified second in the field of 47, with a four-game total of 985 on games of 247, 299, 195 and 244. He was seeded into the second round, but in match play he beat Steven Parsons of Roseville 247-194 and Chris Steward of Waterford 232-176 to advance to the championship match.

Clark qualified fourth with 960, including a high game of 277. He also was seeded into the second round where he beat Michael Snow of Windsor 241-211 and top seed Anthony Wright of Detroit 246-216 on his way to the finals.

Raynes moved into the lead in the season long Cup race with 520 points over last year's Cup champion Gerald Johnson of Taylor with 474 points.

Wright was the top qualifier with 991 and settled for \$50 after losing to Clark.

Men's champion Raynes won the "Battle of the Series" by defeating Robin Orlikowski of Grand Rapids 279-228.
