GERALD JOHNSON WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT CENTURY BOWL

Gerald Johnson of Taylor won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 194-186 triumph over Alex Robinson of Detroit at Century Bowl in Waterford. Johnson took home the top prize of \$500, while Robinson settled for \$250.

Johnson qualified fourth with a four-game total of 878 in the field of 43, on game of 247, 205, 205 and 221. In match play he beat Steven Bas of Chatham, Ontario 199-177 and top qualifier John Bercier of Spring Lake 256-215 to advance to the championship match. With the win he also wins the season long cup with 818 points.

Robinson qualified seventh with 865. He beat Thomas Smith of Pontiac 204-188, David Alexander of Wyandotte 203-192 and Darren Alexander of Essex, Ontario 212-184 on his way to the finals.

Bercier and Darren Alexander finished third and fourth respectively, cashing for \$100 each.

Following Johnson in the cup race are Steven Krywy of Sterling Heights (765) and Lonnie Olsen of Warren (701).
