## **DJ ROSE WINS MEN'S SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES**

Daniel (DJ) Rose of Belleville won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series Invitational event on Sunday with a 247-196 triumph over Darren Alexander of Essex, Ontario. Rose took home the top prize of \$500, while Alexander settled for \$250.

Rose qualified third in the invitational field of 10 with a four-game total of 841 on games of 226, 239, 185 and 191 to advance to the stepladder finals.

Once in the stepladder finals he beat Lonnie Olsen of Warren 183-161 and Cup winner Gerald Johnson of Taylor 226-215 on his way to the final match.

Alexander was easily the top qualifier with 893 on games of 237, 224, 235 and 197. He simply had to wait for an opponent to emerge from the stepladder.

Johnson cashed for \$150 and Olsen \$100.

The top 16 on the points list of the five-event Men's Series were invited to participate in the special event at Shelby Lanes.

After the competition the top 15 in the points list were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Gerald Johnson won the Men's Series cup with 818 points for \$600 for the five-event series, followed by Stephen Krywy of Sterling Heights with 765 points for \$300 and Olsen with 701 points for \$200.
