CHRISTOPHER STEWARD WINS MEN'S SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES

Christopher Steward of Waterford won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series Invitational event on Sunday with a 202-192 triumph over Ryan Land of Royal Oak. Steward took home the top prize of \$500, while Land settled for \$250.

Steward was the top qualifier in the invitational field of 17 with a four-game total of 903 on games of 246, 190, 244 and 223 to advance to the stepladder finals and wait for a challenger.

Land qualified second with 869 on games of 184, 227, 210 and 248. In the stepladder finals he beat Corey Miller of Waterford 256-186. Miller cashed for \$150.

In the first match, Miller defeated Tierre Wright of Eastpointe 201-168 before being defeated by Land. Wright cashed for \$100.

The top 17 qualified based on the points and participation list for the five-event Men's Series and were then invited to participate in the special event at Shelby Lanes.

After the competition, the event participants were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Miller won the Men's Series cup with 779 points for \$600 for the five-event series, followed by Stephen Krywy of Sterling Heights with 705 points for \$300 and Dennis Johnson of Wyoming with 693 points for \$200.
