NICOLE HARRISON WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT MAYFLOWER LANES

Nicole Harrison of Shelby Township won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 205-201 triumph over Sarah Dorow of Midland at Mayflower Lanes in Redford. Harrison took home the top prize of \$500, while Dorow settled for \$250.

Harrison qualified 10th in the field of 36, with a four-game total of 848. She started out strong in qualifying with a 248 game and was steady from there to make the cut by 20 pins. In match play she beat Angela Wilt of Westland 196-189, Jennifer Peretto of Grand Rapids 204-195 and Tanisha Burris of Lansing 234-228 to advance to the finals.

Dorow qualified fourth with 897. She was near the cut after three games and closed strong with a 257 to earn a bye in the first round. Once in match play she defeated Kolien Owens of Mason 224-181 and top qualifier Novella Daniels of Detroit 231-222 on her way to the finals.

Daniels led the field with 934 on games of 258, 202, 269 and 205. She finished third for \$100.
