DASHA KOVALOVA WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL

Dasha Kovalova of Muskegon won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 256-215 triumph over Robin Orlikowski of Grand Rapids at Westland Bowl in Westland. Kovalova took home the top prize of \$500, while Orlikowski settled for \$250.

Kovalova qualified first in the field of 39, with a four-game total of 902 on games of 257, 187, 227 and 231. She earned a bye in the first round, but once match play began she beat Shannon Rowe of Westland 211-169 and Cathleen Maes of Westland 233-169 to advance to the finals.

Orlikowski qualified tenth with 789, which included games of 180, 207, 192 and 210. In reaching the finals, she defeated Angela Wilt of Westland, 212-176, Sarah Dorow of Midland 214-178 and Sandra Schultz of Macomb 213-177 on her way to the finals.
