CATHLEEN MAES WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL

Cathleen Maes of Westland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 179-178 triumph over Stacey Timmer of Wayland at Westland Bowl in Westland. Maes took home the top prize of \$500, while Timmer settled for \$250.

Maes qualified fifth in the field of 33, with a four-game total of 770 on games of 177, 178, 204 and 211. She earned a bye in the first round, but once match play began she beat Susan Rodey of Livonia 204-163 and Sarah Dorow of Midland 184-178 to advance to the finals.

Timmer qualified second with 794, which included games of 225, 189, 212 and 168. She also earned a bye and then defeated Tracey Distel of Lansing 231-176 and Sekeithia Walters-Wright of Eastpointe 221-198 on her way to the finals.

Elizabeth Payeur of Ann Arbor was the top qualifier with 829. She lost her first match to Dorow 202-172 to end her day. She cashed for \$75.
