BRANDIE REAMY WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT VISION LANES

Brandie Reamy of Livonia won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 186-184 over Blair Blumenscheid of Columbus, Ohio at Vision Lanes in Westland. Reamy took home the top prize of \$500, while Blumenscheid settled for \$250.

Last month's runner-up Reamy tied for the top qualifier spot with 823 on games of 246, 182, 182 and 213. In match play she beat Sarah Dorow of Midland 206-131 and Julie Oczepek of Reese 203-198 to advance to the final match. The win over Blumenscheid avenged a loss to Blumenscheid in last year's Rip 10 Women's Series Invitational.

Blumenscheid tied for the last qualifying spot and had to beat Jennifer Peretto of Ferndale 198-146 to earn a spot in match play after a qualifying score of 716. In match play she defeated Mary Wells of Columbus 165-161, Kathleen Bishop of Westland 211-201 and Samantha Hesley of Detroit 223-166 to advance to the finals.

Reamy and Bishop led qualifying with 823. Bishop finished fifth.
