BRANDIE REAMY WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT MAYFLOWER LANES

Brandie Reamy of Livonia won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 210-201 triumph over Jodi Woessner of Oregon, Ohio at Mayflower Lanes in Redford. Reamy took home the top prize of \$500, while Woessner settled for \$250.

Reamy was the top qualifier in the field of 33, with a four-game total of 993 including a high game of 265. In match play she defeated Sandra Schultz of Macomb 203-191 and Elaine Wright of Eaton Rapids 226-288 to advance to the finals. As a result of her win Reamy moved into first place in the season long cup race with 514 points.

Woessner, making her first appearance in the Women's Series this year, qualified third with 915 and a high game of 275. She beat Shannon Rowe of Detroit 210-181 and Stacey Timmer of Wayland 258-208 on her way to the finals.

Timmer finished third and Wright fourth for \$100 each.

Reamy leads the cup race with 514, followed by Valerie Bercier of Spring Lake (503) and Julie Oczepek of Vassar (486).
