STACEY TIMMER WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT CENTURY BOWL

Stacey Timmer of Wayland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 220-193 triumph over Shannon Rowe of Detroit at Century Bowl in Waterford. Timmer took home the top prize of \$500, while Rowe settled for \$250.

Timmer qualified fifth in the field of 31, with a four-game total of 889 including a high game of 255. In match play she defeated Jennifer Maples of Roseville 220-157 and top qualifier Lisa Bishop of Redford 259-215 to advance to the finals. She won in only her second Women's Series event, following a third place finish in March.

Rowe qualified seventh with 875 and a high game of 246. A victory in the title match would have propelled her to win the season long cup race. In match play she beat Brandie Reamy of Livonia 226-224 and Valerie Bercier of Spring Lake 235-185 on her way to the finals.

Bishop finished third and Bercier fourth for \$100 each.

Brandie Reamy of Livonia wins the Cup with 802 points, closely followed by Rowe and Bercier with 794 points each.
