KATHLEEN BISHOP WINS WOMEN'S SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES

Kathleen Bishop of Westland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Rip 10 Entertainment Women's Invitational event on Sunday with a 204-191 triumph over top seed Lauren Roberts of Ferndale at Shelby Lanes in Shelby Township. Bishop took home the top prize of \$500, while Roberts settled for \$250.

Bishop qualified fourth in the invitational field of 16 with a four-game total of 758. Her set included games of 204, 193, 173 and 188.

Roberts was the top qualifier with a four-game total of 829.

Bishop beat Julie Oczepek of Reese 201-191 and Cathleen Kowalski of Livonia 224-153 to advance to the championship match.

Oczepek cashed for \$150 and Kowalski \$100.

The top 16 on the points list of the five-event Women's Series were invited to participate in the special event at Shelby Lanes.

After the competition the top 15 in the points list were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Oczepek won the Women's Series cup with 808 points for \$600 for the five-event series, followed by Brandie Reamy of Livonia with 806 points for \$300 and Sandra Schultz of Macomb with 777 points for \$200 each.
