JULIA HUREN WINS WOMEN'S SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES

Julia Huren of Westland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series Invitational event on Sunday with a 209-134 triumph over Pamela Wilson of Woodhaven. Huren took home the top prize of \$500, while Wilson settled for \$250.

Huren was the top qualifier in the invitational field of 16 with a four-game total of 900 on games of 267, 237, 207 and 189 to advance to the stepladder finals and wait for a challenger.

Wilson qualified third with 818 on games of 152, 198, 233 and 235. In the stepladder finals she beat Kasey Eaton of Wyoming 189-176 and Ashley Everett of Belleville 215-173 on her way to the finals.

Everett cashed for \$150 and Eaton \$100.

The top 16 on the points list of the five-event Women's Series were invited to participate in the special event at Shelby Lanes.

After the competition the top 15 in the points list were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Kasey Eaton won the Women's Series cup with 811 points for \$600 for the five-event series, followed by Julia Huren with 766 points for \$300 and Cathleen Maes of Westland with 723 points for \$200.
